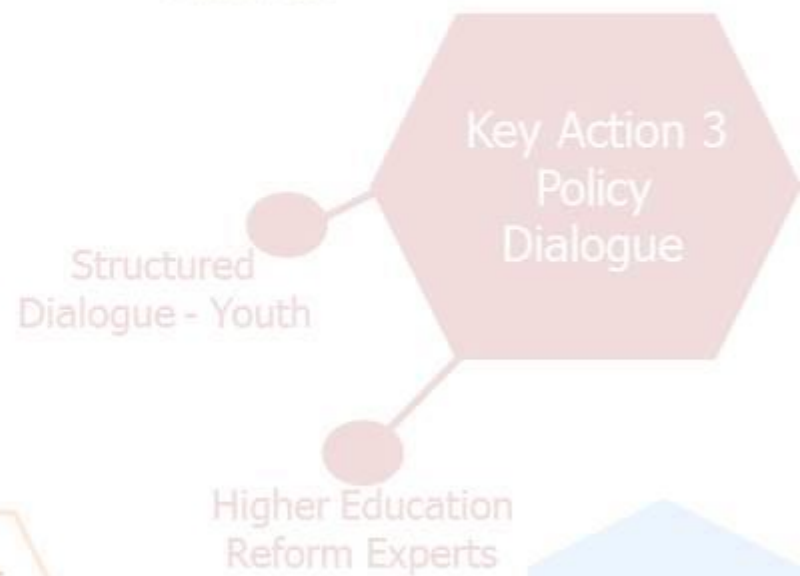

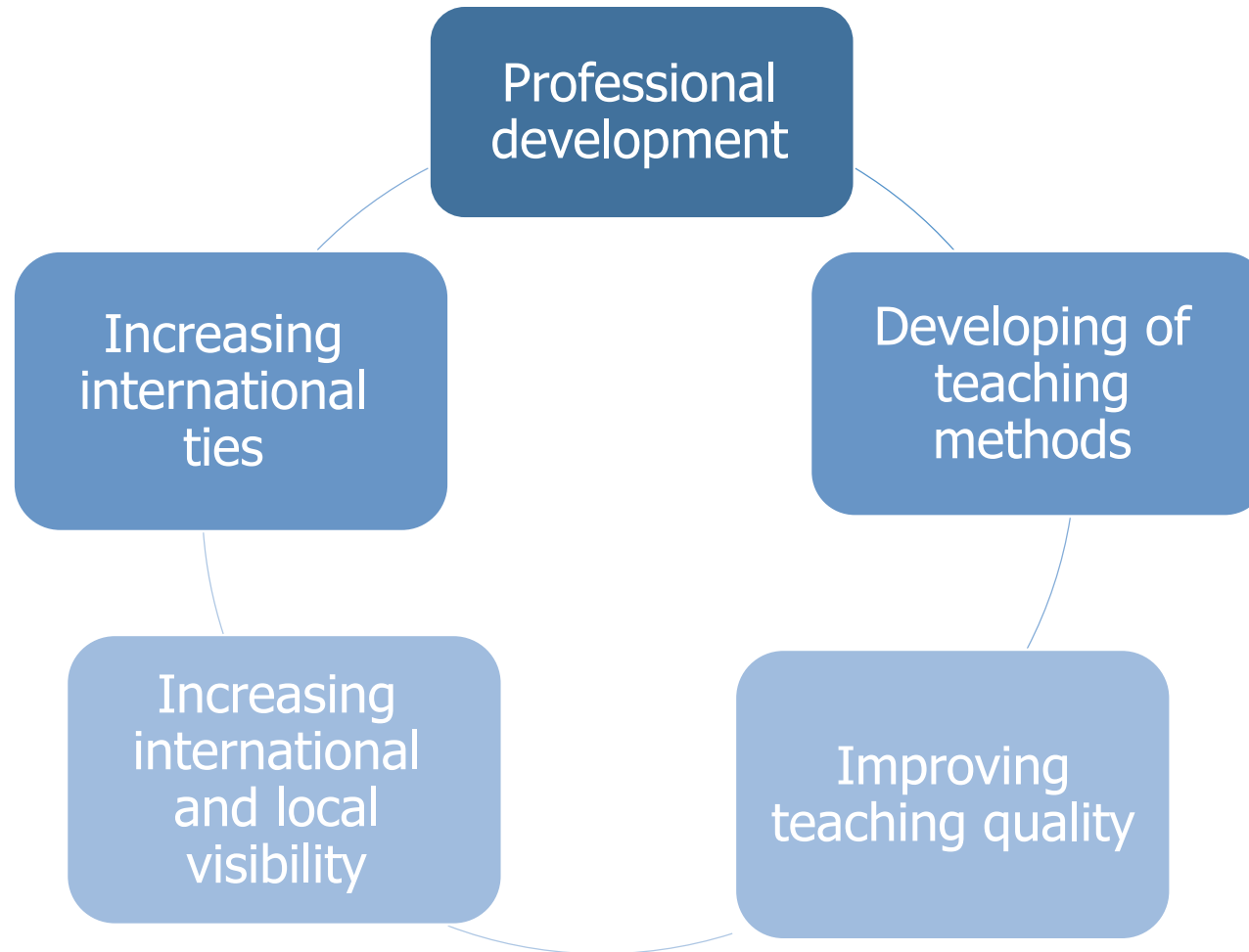

What is International Credit Mobility?


-  Based on **bilateral agreements** between institutions
-  Forms are filled and submitted by the **European Institution**
-  Managed by the **National Agencies** in the various Programme countries
-  Forecast for **135,000 grants** over 6 years
-  For staff and students from **all cycles** and **all disciplines**
-  Students – **between 3 to 12 months**
-  Staff – **between 5 days to 2 months** including mandatory 8 teaching hours per week

Important to note

Based on the Erasmus Quality Framework:

-  The European institution must be a [HEI awarded with an ECHE](#)
-  Mutual recognition of credits must be guaranteed
-  Double tuition is not permitted
-  Both sending and receiving institutions must be able to ensure student and staff support

Evaluation Criteria

-  **Relevance of the strategy** - The extent to which the planned mobility project is relevant to the internationalisation strategy of the higher education institutions involved (both in the Programme and in the Partner country) and the rationale for choosing staff and/ or student mobility.
-  **Quality of the cooperation arrangements** - The extent to which the applicant organisation has previous experience of similar projects with higher institutions in the partner country and the clarity of the description of responsibilities, roles and tasks between partners.
-  **Quality of the activity design and implementation** - The completeness and quality of arrangements for the selection of participants, the support provided to them and the recognition of their mobility period (in particular in the Partner country).
-  **Impact and dissemination** - The potential impact of the project on participants, beneficiaries, partner organisations, at local, regional and national levels and the quality of measures aimed at disseminating the results of the mobility project at faculty and institution levels, and beyond where applicable, in both the programme and partner countries.
