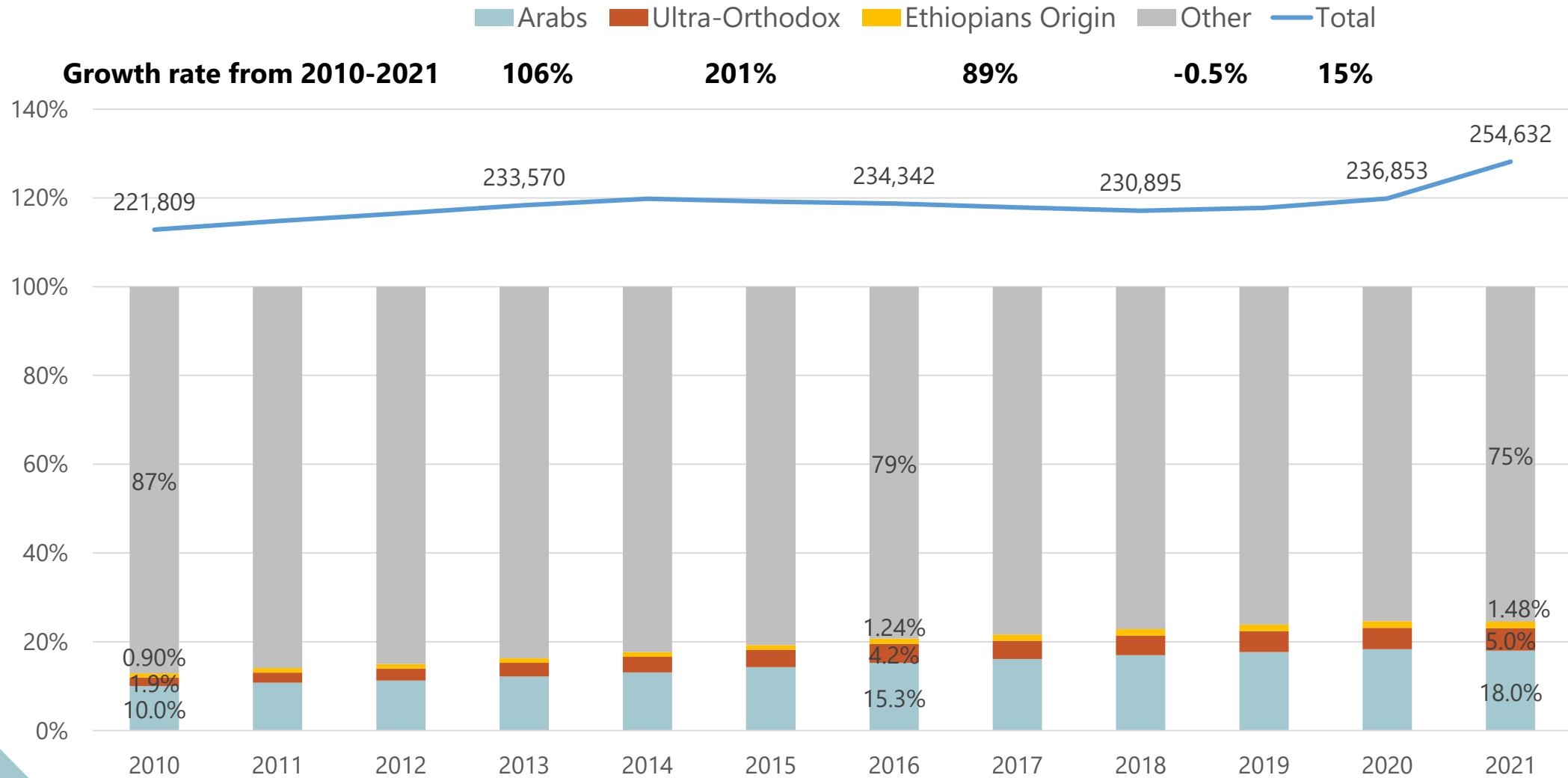

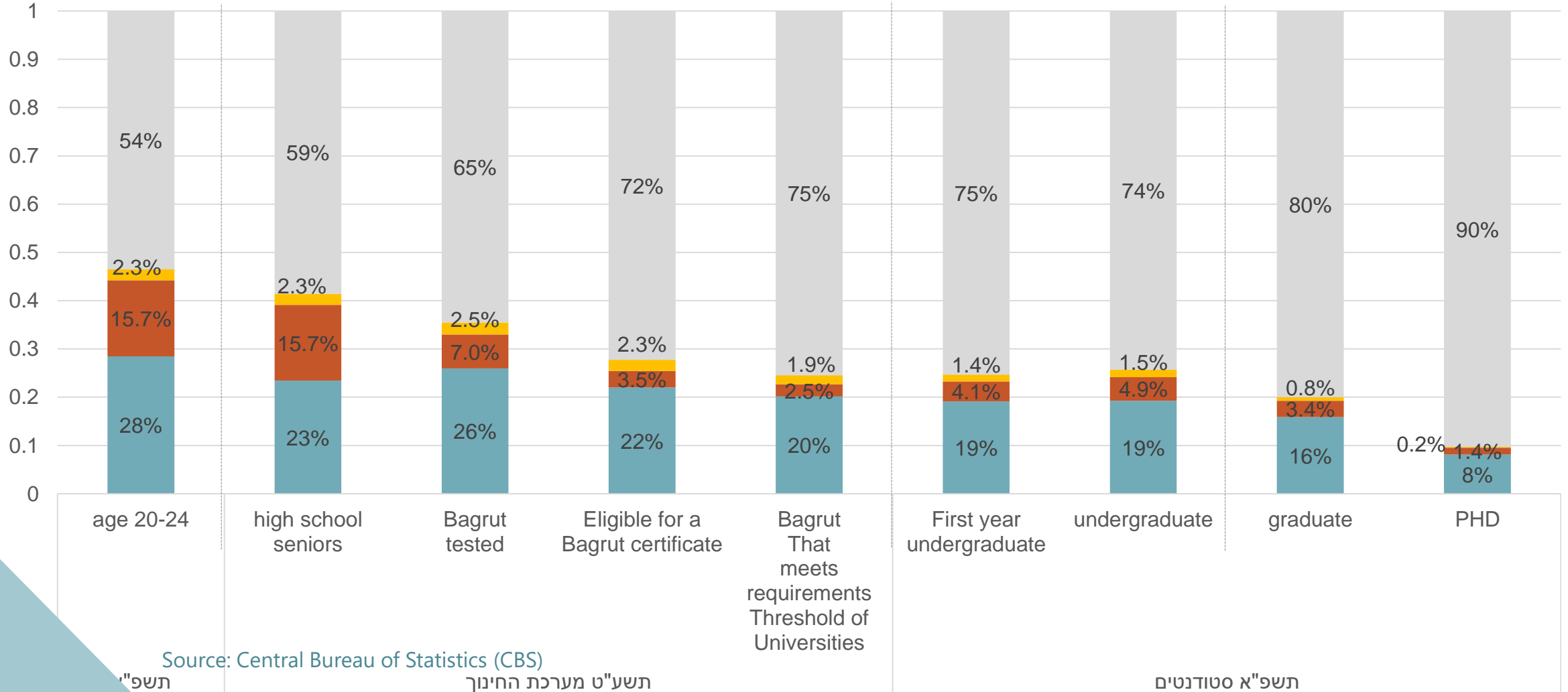
Undergraduates Representation of Minority Groups: 13% in 2010 - 25% in 2021

 ■ other



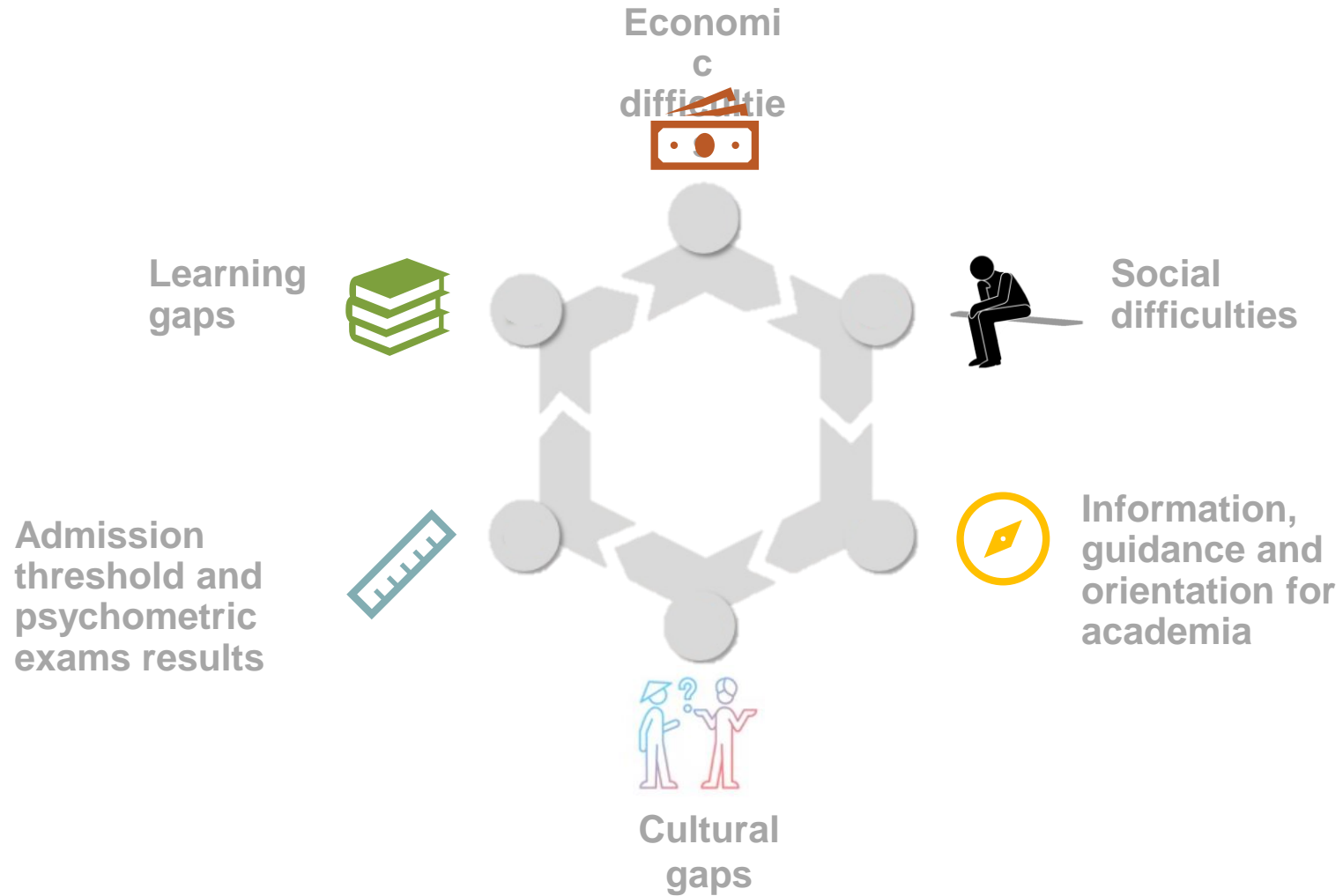

A holistic Approach to Tackling Inclusion Barriers



Accessibility programs operate holistically across the various stages, while establishing accessibility infrastructure

Pre-academic

In community:

- Encouragement programs for academia (future image-making workshops and tours in the institutions)
- Counseling and guidance programs in high schools, youth centers and employment centers (bureaus)
- Preparatory courses for psychometrics, Amir and Yael

In academic institutions:

- Pre-academic preparatory courses for completing basic studies, economic scholarships & academic support system
- Summer Programs "Step Before Everyone"
- Recognition of alternative acceptance mechanisms

First degree

- Economic support system: Economic aid scholarships
- Academic support system: Tutoring and mentoring, Funding for disabilities diagnoses Learning, emotional support, Orientation workshops and cultural integration, social gatherings
- Excellence Program for STEM Studies

Advanced degrees

- Economic and academic support system
- Excellence Scholarships: Master's Degree, PHD Postdoctoral, Admission of academic staff

Infrastructure

- Institutional Commissioner for Diversity, Partnership and Inclusion + Institutional Steering Committee
- Learning sessions for the academic and administrative staff

- Establishment of academic colleges
- Establishment of programs designed for the ultra-Orthodox in the preparatory schools and for a bachelor's degree for Arabs in the preparatory schools
