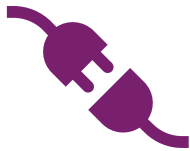

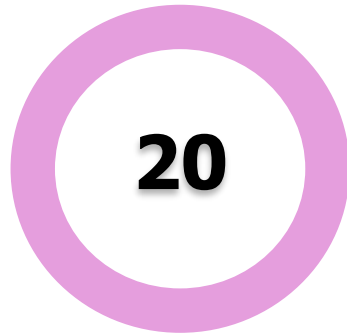

Scope of Erasmus+ Local Activity 2015-2024



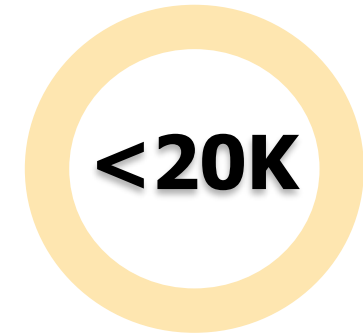

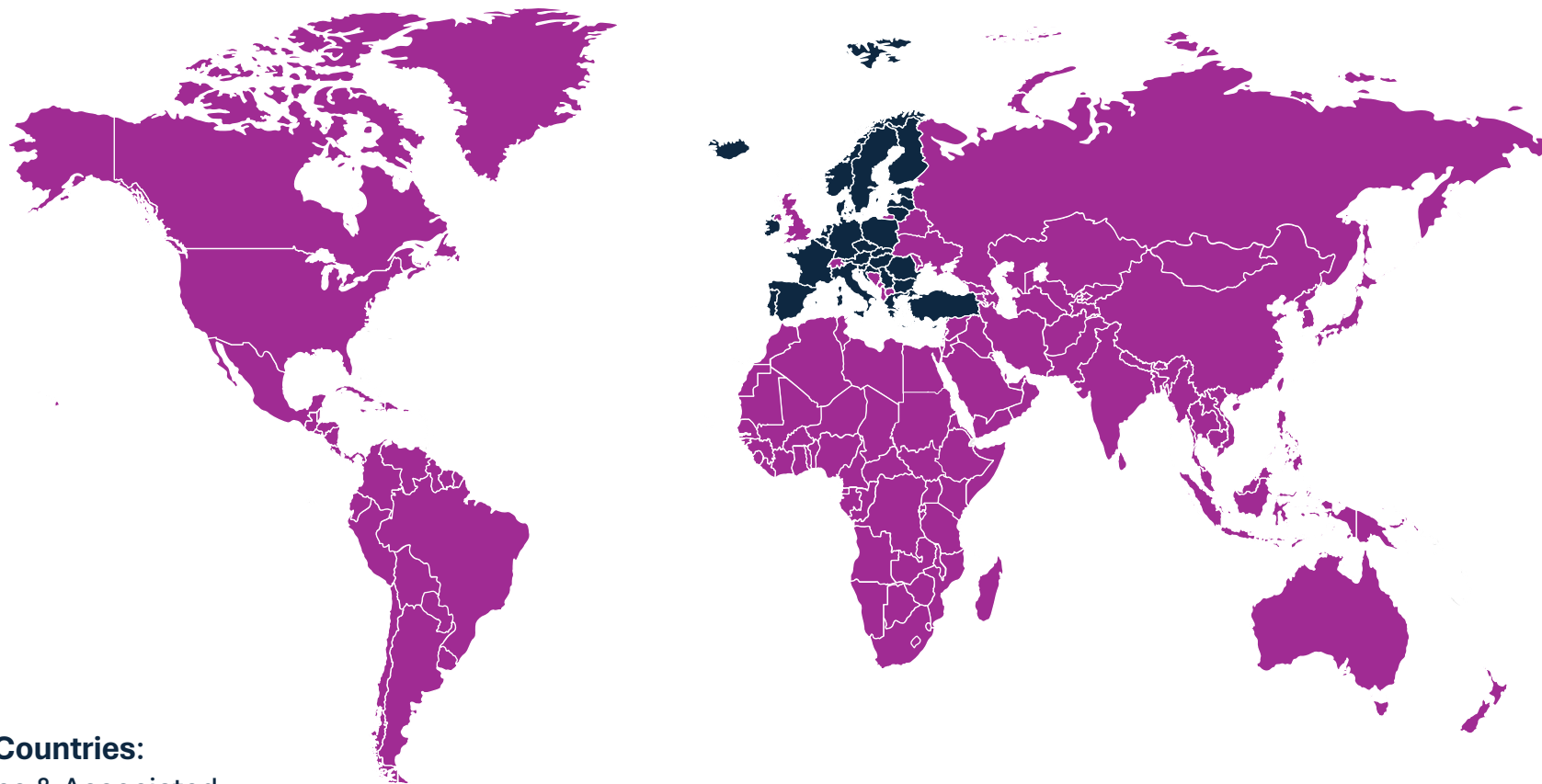

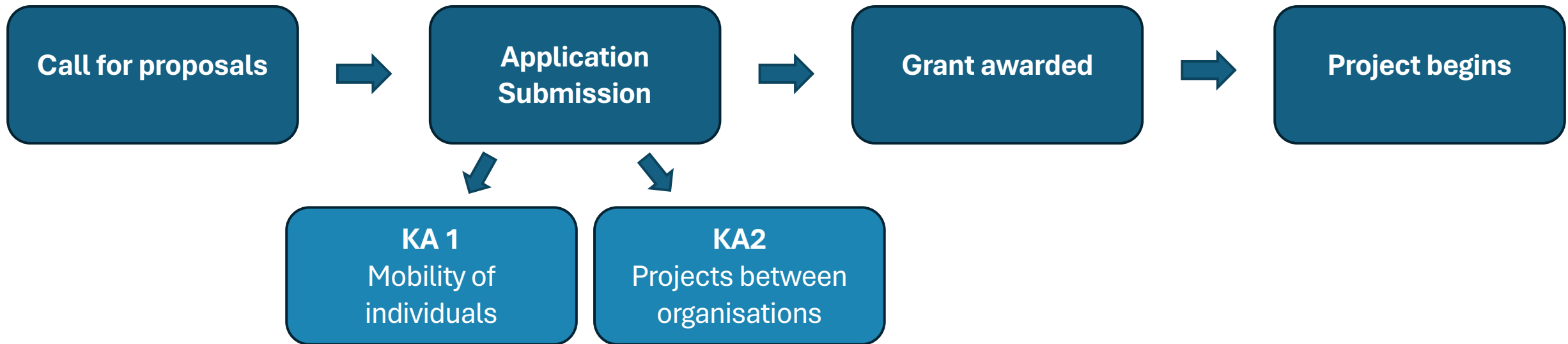

Youth Mobility

Youth groups from different countries meet for informal learning (5-21 days)

Min. four participants from a single organisation (maximum 60)

Mobility of Youth Workers

Professional development and training (2-60 days)

Student and Staff Mobility

Study/internships – 2 Months up to a Year
Staff – Teaching/Training – 5-60 days

Cooperation Partnerships

This is an inter-EU call open to Israeli Organizations with essential added value. These partnerships aim to improve the quality and relevance of organizational activities and national/regional/EU-level impact in different fields.

Capacity Building in the field of Vocational Education and Training

A project to improve vocational Education and training for the job market (not academic) that has national importance.

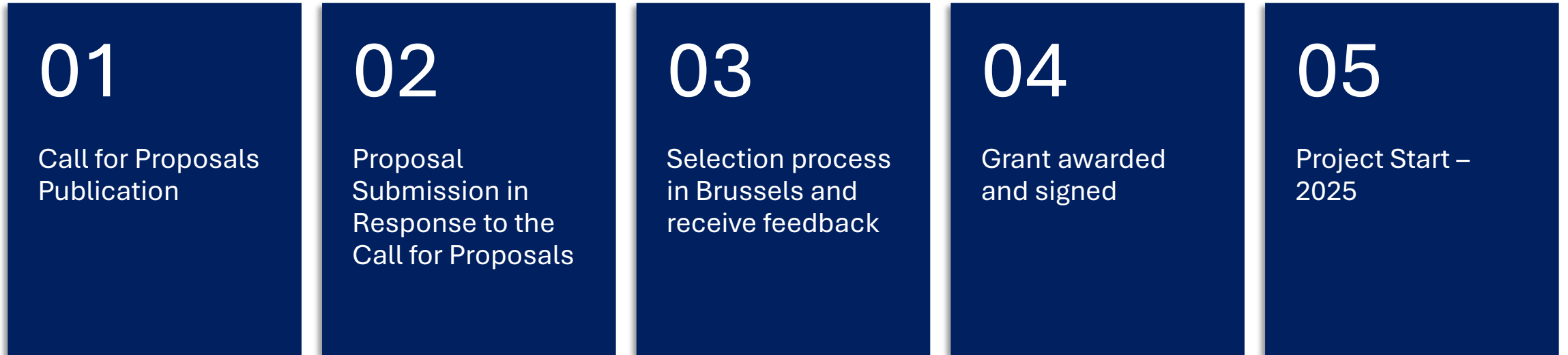
How to get started?

- 1 Identify an urgent, strategic, institutional, regional or national need that is not being met/funded by another source
- 2 Find partners or collaborators with strong relevance and motivation
- 3 Map the needs, activities, applications, and desired outcomes
- 4 Work together on delivering innovative and impactful projects and deliverables

Important Tips

- Can't have more EU partners than non-EU partners
- A large consortium is a strong consortium with more potential impact
- Your EU partners might already be involved in Erasmus – Just ask them!

Submission Process



*Mobility projects grants are generally announced a few months after selection
