

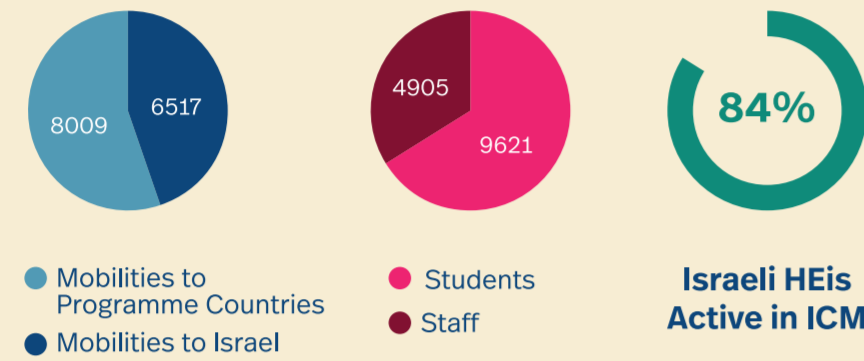
ERASMUS+ IN ISRAEL



ERASMUS+: OPENING DOORS OPENING MINDS

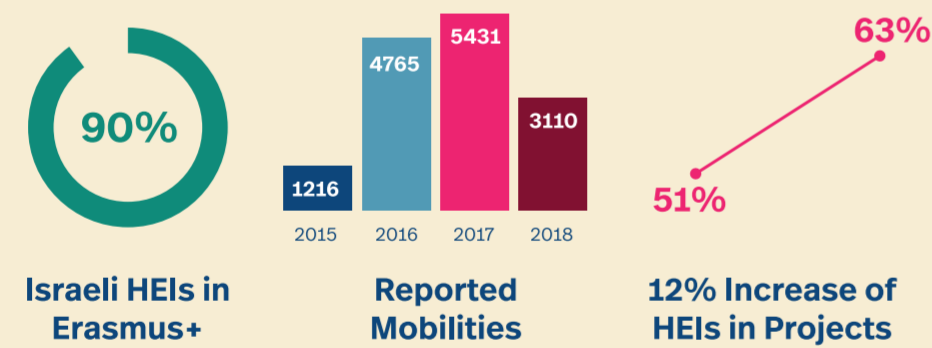

9 out of 10 of our institutions, Universities, Academic Colleges, and Colleges for Education from all over Israel are actively participating in Erasmus+ actions. The programme has led to a steep increase in participation, and the programme bolsters change and development in different academic fields and institutions. Today, a diverse group of students, staff and institutions all around Israel benefit from Erasmus+ and the new opportunities that contribute to personal and professional growth for all.



IMPROVING TEACHING AND LEARNING

Capacity Building Projects led to dozens of new courses and to the development of new approaches and tools that changed the way of teaching and the learning in Israel. Students benefit from new content, student centred teaching and smart classrooms. The academic staff is able to deliver updated knowledge in creative and innovative ways.

The Erasmus+ community includes a growing group of change makers within Israeli Higher Education Institutions participating in Erasmus+ programmes. 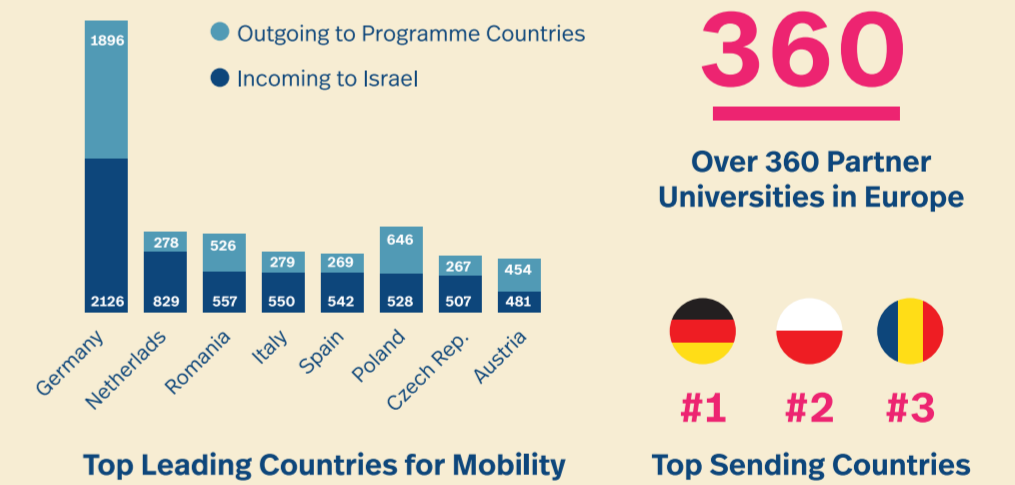
NEW VISIONS & INSTITUTIONAL STRATEGIES

Joint projects have contributed to fundamental institutional changes and to the development and implementation of new strategies within Israeli HEIs. Over the last years, new institutional visions, hubs and centres were established, promoting innovation in teaching, social responsibility and excellence. Moreover, through administrative staff mobility and Capacity Building projects, management key figures in the Universities and Colleges have transformed their mindsets and became agents of change within their institutions.



GROWING COOPERATION BETTER PARTNERSHIPS

Israeli HEIs have built strong networks and increased the number of partnerships thanks to the diverse opportunities of Erasmus+. HEIs in Israel collaborate with over 360 HEIs around Europe. More importantly, the quality, the strategic approach and the academic ambition in these partnerships grow from year to year, allowing partners to engage in meaningful impact driven knowledge exchange.



HIGHER EDUCATION POLICY DEVELOPMENT

Cooperation projects together with the Israeli HERE activities have had a significant impact on the national policy level. From teaching excellence reforms to the inclusion of the Creative Industry in a new governmental program to stimulate economic growth – the national impact of Erasmus+ is evident. Based on the expertise of 14 Experts (TAM) major policy reforms and new initiatives in the field of Internationalisation, Entrepreneurship and Quality Assurance were introduced at the Council for Higher Education.
