**Mr. Andy Gibbs** is a European Higher Education Expert and former UK Bologna Expert with wide ranging involvement in supporting European Higher Education Reforms in the UK and beyond. He has led a curriculum and policy development events and projects, with Ministries and universities, on Higher Education Reforms in more than 30 countries worldwide. He was inaugural Chair of the United Kingdom Outward Mobility Group and Steering Committee member of the Scottish Mobility Group. He is a member of the European University Association Institutional Evaluation Pool, undertaking 18 reviews and has participated as Chair, secretary and panel member in ENQA (the European Quality Agency) and over 50 national quality agency reviews. A former President of the Florence European Nursing and Midwifery Network, he has contributed to EU policy dialogue on Skilled European Health and Social Care workforce; and Migration and European Healthcare. He has established transnational education programmes in Europe, Singapore and China. Andy has published articles related to Higher Education integration and reform on Europe, China and ASEAN. He was adviser on Bologna/Higher Education reform expert training seminars to UNICA/Brussels Education Foundation, a member of the Bologna Follow Up Working Group on recognition of qualifications and is a steering committee member for UK NARIC Quality and Standards Group. Andy is a former Head of School of Community Health at Edinburgh Napier University and is currently an Assoc. Lecturer and Visiting Prof at Asia Europe Institute, University of Malaya. Recently he has undertaken projects on the extended scope of the European Qualifications Framework (European Commission), Strategic Directions in Learning Teaching and Recognition (World Bank), Alignment of Credit Systems (CHED, Philippines) Recognition of Qualifications for Refugees and Migrants (EU).
